

OUR FACILITY

Guest housing is located on the 4th floor of Goodhue Hall. Centrally located on the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater's campus, Goodhue Hall is situated off of Starin Road, between The Kettle Moraine Bookstore and Fischer Hall. Guest Housing offers a convenient, reasonably priced option for commuter students, faculty and others associated with the University.

An air-conditioned lounge is furnished with a television, VCR, computer, microwave, couches, tables, and chairs. Bathroom and showering facilities are located in the center of the floor and include a coin-operated washer and dryer in each. Vending machines and a pay phone are conveniently located in the lobby of Goodhue Hall on the ground floor. A professional staff member lives on the floor and is available to assist guests with concerns and emergencies.

Long term stays can be accommodated. Please call or visit our office for further details.

SUITES

Our suites provide a motel feel, including a bedroom area and a private bathroom. They are economical and include:

- Queen Bed
- Television with 55 channel cable, including our movie channel
- Microwave and Compact Refrigerator
- Phone, including free local calls
- Desk, Chairs, and Dresser
- Towels and Linens

STANDARD GUEST ROOMS

A number of rooms are available which resemble our standard residence hall rooms. These rooms are carpeted and provide basic and inexpensive accommodations. They include the following:

Monday through Friday: 9:00am - 11:00pm

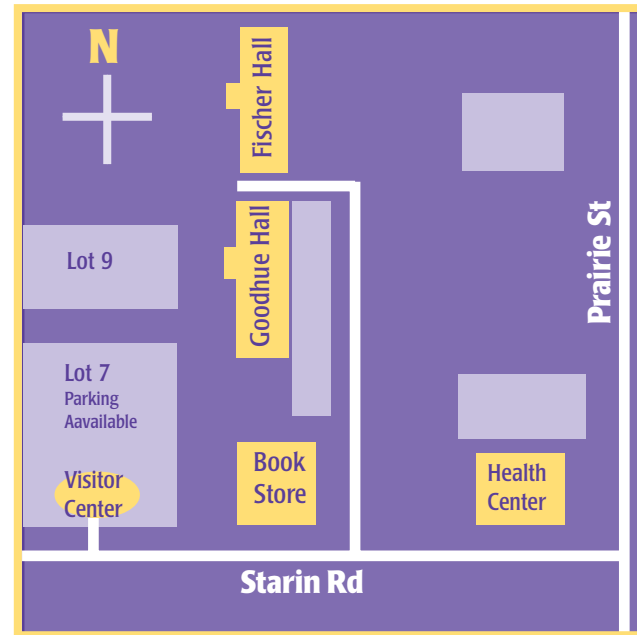
Saturday and Sunday: 12:00pm - 6:00pm
